Language Matters

Language is powerful – especially when talking about substance use Stigmatizing Language perpetuates negative perceptions

"Person first" language focuses on the person, not the disorder

When Discussing Addictions...

Avoid These Terms:

Addict, user, drug abuser, junkie

Addicted baby

Opioid abuse or opioid dependence

Problem

Habit

Gean or dirty urine test

Opioid substitution or replacement therapy

Relapse

Treatment failure

Being dean

Use These Instead :

Person/Patient with opioid use disorder or opioid addiction

Baby born with neonatal abstinence syndrome

Opioid use disorder

Disease

Drug addiction

Negative or positive urine drug test

Opioid agonist treatment Medication for Addiction Treatment Return to use/ Setback

Treatment attempt

Being in remission or recovery
